



Meet Information

1. This meet is held under Swim England Laws.
2. All competitors must be registered with Swim England or their own national association as appropriate
3. Closing Date Friday 4 October 2019
4. Age on the 31st December 2019
5. Pool length is 25 metres it has 6 lanes fitted with anti-wave lane ropes
6. Electronic timing system will be in operation
7. Age groups are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs & 14yrs. (Please note 9yrs are able to enter 50m and 200m events only).
8. 1500m & 800m Events age groups are 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs & 15yrs
9. Upper limit times will apply. Swimmers must not have swam faster than the upper time limit and any swimmers entered on times above the upper time for their age and event will be excluded. All entry times must be converted to 25m pool times by use of the Swim England Conversion tables.

14. Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in age group events
15. All competitors must go through marshalling for both heats and finals. If a competitor does not report to marshalling in time, the event will proceed without the competitor
16. If a swimmer does not intend to swim a final, please notify the recorders immediately so a reserve can be called
17. Except for the 50m events, all other events will be Heat Declared Winners. 50m events will have age groups finals
18. Skins will be held at the end of each AM session. Qualifiers will be selected from the fastest six male and female 12 & under and 13/14 yrs 200m Individual Medley competitors (events 4 & 41).
19. A swim down facility with lanes will be available throughout the gala.
20. Lead referee for the event is Tracy Donnelly
